Morocco - Outdoor Adventure Girls Itinerary

Day 1

Destination: Marrakech **Meals Included:** Dinner

Salaam Aleikum! Welcome to Morocco. This Women's Expedition begins with a welcome meeting at 6pm – please check the hotel reception for information about where and when it will be. After the meeting there's the option of joining your leader and fellow travellers for dinner. Afterwards, be sure to check out Djemaa el Fna, the lively town square in the centre of the Medina. Huge crowds converge at night to see singers, drummers, dancers, fortune tellers, jugglers and even old medicine men and dentists mingling together in what has been called the 'greatest spectacle on earth'. If you arrive in town with some time up your sleeve before the trip starts, perhaps admire the outside view of the Koutoubia Mosque and its famous minaret, or discover the tropical gardens of the French painter Jacques Majorelle (now owned by Yves Saint Laurent). Also well worth a look is the architecture of the Palais Bahia, the ruins of the Palais Badi, and the recently uncovered Saadian tombs in the Medina.

Day 2 - Bou Tharar

Meals Included: Breakfast, Dinner

Board your private transport and settle in for the journey to Bou Tharar village. You'll be hosted by local women, and there will be some Amazigh (Berber) music and local songs to enjoy. A tasty, traditional meal will be waiting for you on arrival. Your accommodation is a beautiful terra cotta gite (rural guesthouse). From here, the views of the surrounding hills are superb, and you'll be greeted with warm hospitality from the local family who run the establishment.

Today's total driving time is approximately 5 hours.

Day 3 - Agouti

Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Set off on a hike from Bou Tharar village to Agouti Village (approximately 5–6 hours). You'll be accompanied by one of the region's first local female guides. Your guide knows these parts like the back of her hand and will share incredible stories of the landscape and her nomadic past – this is sure to be one of the standout experiences of your journey. You'll be hiking in a westbound direction, passing through villages and meeting some of the locals on the way. In the afternoon, learn how to prepare some specialty dishes at a cooking demonstration. This is a really unique opportunity, so get involved and learn some new skills to take back home. Perhaps the most important part of the

evening is watching how couscous is prepared in a traditional way. It's a classic and characterful component of Maghrebi cuisine. Its rice-like softness is perfect for soaking up the rich and buttery slow-cooked tagines found all over Morocco. The locals will show you the tricks to getting it just right.

Day 4 - Todra Gorges

After breakfast, Trekking for 1h30 to reach the transportation to I make your way to Todra Gorge. This is a long travel day, so make sure you have a book handy! After a while, you'll come across a bright tablecloth of green that might seem so out of place, This valley is pretty impressive, with all its palm trees and mud-brick villages. Arrive at your hotel at the top of the valley, and take some time to relax, recharge and chill out under the palms.

Today travel south to the famed Ait Benhaddou. The scenic drive will take you past ancient kasbah ruins, former colonial military outposts, austere mountains, and valleys of palm trees and irrigated fields. Pause for lunch in Ouarzazate, where movies such as Lawrence of Arabia, The Sheltering Sky, and Black Hawk Down were filmed. Time permitting, you may also have time to take a tour of the Atlas Movie Studios. Afterward, continue on to your destination of Ait Benhaddou. Centuries ago, this was an important stop for caravans carrying salt across the Sahara. Today, its grand kasbah, a fine example of clay architecture, has been listed as a World Heritage site

Day 7 - Agafay

After breakfast take a 4hours drive to a desert located about thirty kilometers from the red city of Marrakech, on the first heights of the High Atlas massif in Morocco. It is covered with stones and rocks in a hilly environment made up of dunes with white and ocher tones. In the evening meet your camel leader for instructions over mint tea. Then hop on your camel, and ride through a light-brown highland of rocky desert with the High Atlas Mountain looming from distance. Later you will experience an unforgettable dinner under the shiny stars in the heart of the nearby desert Agafay.
