Day 1

Destination: Arrival Bali (IATA: DPS) – Ubud

Meals Included: Dinner

Welcome to Bali! Upon arrival at Bali please make your way to the Golden Bird Lounge after clearing immigration. After you exit customs walk to the Golden Bird Lounge which is on the right side (around 50 meters from where you exit customs). Give your name details at the Golden Bird desk and our team would assist you to get the driver and transfer you to your hotel in Ubud.

At 6pm, join a welcome meeting followed by dinner with the group and your leader. Have the opportunity to enjoy a delicious meal while connecting with fellow travellers, sharing excitement about the upcoming adventures, and getting acquainted with the group.

Day 2

Destination: Ubud

After breakfast, meet our friends, a local woman who will show us how to make a traditional offering of fresh flowers, tell us what it means, and why they do it. Offerings have deep cultural meanings and are part of a Balinese woman's everyday life. After you make your own offering, we will be invited into a private family temple for a mini lesson about the symbolism of the statues and alters inside.

After crafting your own canang sari, proceed to the serene Gunung Kawi Sabtu Temple and devotees in a serene purification ceremony. This sacred ritual involves cleansing your body and soul in the temple's holy spring water, believed to have healing properties.

Today, you'll venture into the picturesque landscapes of Bali to visit Tegallalang Rice Terraces and discover the mesmerizing beauty of Blangsinga Waterfall. This tour combines the charm of Balinese nature and culture, offering a perfect blend of tranquillity and adventure.

Your first stop takes you to the world-famous Tegallalang Rice Terraces, known for their stunning panoramic views and intricate rice paddies. As you walk through the emerald-green terraces, marvel at the intricate irrigation system that has been in place for centuries. Capture breathtaking photos against the backdrop of these lush landscapes while gaining insights into traditional Balinese agriculture.

Continue your adventure to Blangsinga Waterfall, a hidden gem in Bali's heartland. A short trek will lead you to the mesmerizing waterfall, where you can feel the cool mist on your skin and enjoy the natural beauty of the surroundings. Dip your feet in the refreshing pool at the base of the waterfall or simply sit back and soak in the serenity.

Day 5

Destination: Ubud – Candidasa

Meals Included: Breakfast

Waking up early morning, then you will drive to the North of Ubud for approximately 1.5 hour to the starting point of Mt. Batur trekking. Departs from 3:30am climb to the top of the active volcano of Mt. Batur to see the unforgettable sunrise with a spectacular views and vibrations from the holy earth fill your mind and soul.

After descending the volcano, there's an option to soak in hot springs with fantastic views over the lake and caldera before drive back to your hotel in Ubud.

Afterwards, drive back to your hotel, wrap up your luggage and check out from the hotel for your next trip to Candidasa (approx. 2 hours drive). The rest of the program will be free at leisure.

Special Information

The summit trail starts more easily, while heading to the crater it climbs steeply with switchbacks over volcanic rocks and gravel. A good level of fitness is required. The path can be slippery, particularly after rain so good shoes are essential. Please bring your headtorch and a warm layer to wear at the summit. The climb may be cancelled during heavy rain and unsafe conditions.

At appropriate time, drive to Padang Bai Port for your departure to Gili Trawangan by fast boat. The trip with fast boat would take approximately 2 hours to Gili Trawangan.

Upon arrival in Trawangan, you will be provided with bicycles for check-in at your hotel, and your luggage will be transported directly using a horse cart.

Important Information

- Travel is always an adventure and, as destinations reopen, there are a few challenges as everyone gets back up to speed and adjusts to the new normal. Our leaders are experts when it comes to dealing with anything unexpected along the journey, so pack your understanding and flexibility, sit back and relax while they take care of the rest.
- All costs are per person in GBP based on indicated number of passengers travelling together as one movement. No arrangements are being held at this point and the costing is subject to availability at time of booking. In order to proceed, a deposit of GBP200 per person is required and the remaining balance will need to be supplied at 70 days prior to departure.

Special Conditions

Final Balance

- Final balance payment is required 70 days prior to travel.

Cancellation by the traveller

- Cancellation prior to 70 days; we will hold the deposit amount as a credit.
- Cancellation 70 days or inside prior to travel will incur 100% cancellation fees
- No shows will be treated as a cancellation and will incur 100% cancellation fees.

Cancellation by Intrepid

- Cancellation is in line with those detailed in the standard Intrepid booking conditions in clause 8.

Travel Insurance

Travel insurance is mandatory for all our travellers and must be taken out at the time of booking. Your travel insurance must provide cover against personal accident, death, medical expenses and emergency repatriation with a recommended minimum coverage of US\$200,000 for each of the categories of cover. We also strongly recommend it covers cancellation, curtailment, personal liability and loss of luggage and personal effects. You must provide your travel insurance policy number and the insurance company's 24-hour emergency contact number on the first day of your trip; you will not be able to join the trip without these details.

Booking Conditions

- A contract will exist when we accept your deposit.
- If we, or a third-party operator, is required to make amendments to your original proposal, subsequent pricing may become applicable to your booking.
- Any changes to the itinerary made by you AFTER services have been confirmed will require a revised quote and may be subject to an additional charge (as levied by hotels, ground operators or airlines). No additional changes are permitted within 30 days prior to departure.
- Hotels listed in the quote are indicative only and are subject to change. If the hotel listed in the quote is unavailable, we will confirm an alternative hotel of similar standard.
- If complimentary transfers are included, (on a group basis) they are only applicable if going to accommodation booked through us. Please advise flight arrival details (flight number and arrival time) at least 30 days prior to departure if you wish to have this transfer provided. There is no guarantee we can arrange this transfer if we receive these details within 30 days of departure.
